Show/Exhibition Sheep



Health Certificate - issued within 30 days of entry

Official identification, testing and statements listed on health certificate



Import Permit Numbers are Required for Hand-Written Paper Health Certificates ONLY

Official Identification

All show/exhibition sheep require official identification

Official USDA ear tag, breed registration tattoo, scrapie premises ID tag, or premises tattoo

Documentation
Requirements

Testing

- No testing required
- Required Statement: *"While in Montana, these sheep will be used for exhibition only and cannot be sold or used for breeding."*

Scrapie

Required Statement: *"The animals in this shipment were not exhibiting clinical signs associated with scrapie at the time of the examination."*

Prohibited Species

(Including but not limited to) Mouflon, Mouflon cross, Barbary, Tahr, Chamois, Aoudad, Barbados, Hawaiian, and Black Hawaiian.
