All animals require official ID Identification must be listed on the international health certificate

Import Requirements

Brucellosis

Sexually intact animals 6 months of age and over:

- One negative brucellosis test.

Tuberculosis (TB)

Sexually intact animals over the age of 2 months:

- One negative TB test.

Scrapie

Required statement: *“The animals in this shipment were not exhibiting clinical signs associated with scrapie at the time of the examination.”*
