Canadian Origin Horses, Donkeys, Mules, and Zebras




Health Certificate - issued within 30 days of entry

Official identification, testing and statements listed on health certificate



Import Permit

Permits are not required for equines being imported from Canada.



Official Identification

Description: Age, color, sex, and breed of equine

OR

An equine microchip (number must be listed on the health certificate)



Horses, Donkeys, Mules, and Zebras

Requirements

Equine Infectious Anemia (EIA)

One negative EIA test on all classes of equine within a 12 months prior to entry.

- Exemption: Nursing foals under 6 months accompanied by EIA negative dam.
